

3 common hindrances to giving live, anointed by God's Spirit, messages

The anointing is the Holy Spirit, my teacher, without Whom I can't receive a live message

1 John 2:27 **The anointing which you have received from Him** (the Father) **...teaches you about all things, and is truth...**

John 14:26 (Jesus) **...The Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in My name, He will teach you all things...**

God's anointing creates the fruit of my lips, without Whom I cannot give a live message

2 Cor 3:5-6 **...God has made us able ministers of the new covenant, not of the letter** (the written word) **but of the Spirit; for the letter kills** (not having power to overcome sin, it only condemns) **but the Holy Spirit gives life** (to the written word making it alive).

1 Pe 4:11 **Whoever speaks, is to do so as one who speaks the utterances of God** (God speaking His words from our hearts by His Spirit); **whoever ministers is to do so with the ability** (the Holy Spirit) **whom God supplies...** NASU (So who does God anoint?)

Heb 1:9 (Because) **You have loved righteousness and hated sin; therefore God, Your God, has anointed You with the oil** (the Holy Spirit) **of gladness...**

Three anointing killers: unbelief due to care, confidence in self, presuming God will repeat

1. Where there is care of any kind, like, am I supposed to speak, will I hear, will it fulfill what others expect of me, there will be none of Christ's faith. For there is no care in love. As a little child I am to always expect the confirming witness of God's Spirit to my spirit, that I am to speak, and what it is God wants to say through me. I am to never put up with anything less than this. When my heart is certain of this, the anointing by Whom I receive a message will remain with me to give it. Where there is faith there will be no care.

Heb 11:6 **Without faith it is impossible to please God, for those who come to God must believe that He is, and that He rewards those who diligently seek Him.**

1 Co 2:15 **The spiritual person discerns everything...**(hears and does God's will) AMP

2. Pride in self's ability to discover, by use of reason, God's will for a message. My head may think the result is brilliant, but my heart, with its voice of conscience, will not be at peace. Since God intends any message to come from my heart I'm now in real trouble. There will never be a successful outcome without these truths being literally practiced.

Prov 3:5-6 **Trust in the Lord with all your heart, don't try to figure things out with your own intelligence; listen for His voice in everything you do and everywhere you go, And He will direct your paths** (you'll be alive and so give live messages). NKJV MSGE

3. The presumption that, since I'm occupied with many time consuming things, God will simply give again through me an anointed message, like He has given through me in the past. Even though, because of the cares of this world, and the desire for other things, I'm not in the same, intimate, dependant fellowship with Him, that I was, and my heart knows it.

Ps 19:13 **Keep back Your servant also from presumptuous sins; let them not have dominion over me. Then I shall be blameless, and innocent of great transgression.**
