

Ten Bible verses that describe and can impart a Christian life in the Spirit, that belongs to Christ, is dead to self, and that restores fallen Christians

I have 2 natures, bad and good, only as I surrender to the Holy Spirit can I live in the good

Galatians 5:16 I say then: Walk in the Spirit and you will not fulfill the lust of the flesh.

AMP Walk and live habitually in the Holy Spirit, (your will or soul) responsive to and controlled and guided by the Spirit (in your spirit); then you will certainly not gratify the cravings and desires of the flesh, of human nature without God.

17 **TEV For what our human nature wants is opposed to what the Spirit wants, and what the Spirit wants is opposed to what our human nature wants.**

These two are enemies, and this means that you cannot do, are prevented from doing AMP (by God's Spirit), what you (by your human nature) want to do.

18 **If the Spirit leads you, then you are not subject to the Law (as a rule book). TEV**

Gal 5:22 The fruit of the Holy Spirit, the work which His presence within (our spirits)

AMP accomplishes, is love, joy (gladness), peace, patience, (an even temper, forbearance), kindness, goodness (benevolence), faithfulness,

23 **Gentleness (meekness, humility), self-control (self-restraint – really, God restraining self). Against such things there is no law that can bring a charge.**

To belong to Christ permanently, I will need to believe I died with Him to my human nature

24 **AMP Those who belong to Christ Jesus have crucified the flesh (the godless human nature) with its passions and appetites and desires. (I believe I am crucified with Christ, nevertheless I live, yet not I but Christ lives in me...Gal 2:20).**

Gal 5:25 TEV The Spirit has given us life; He must also control our lives.

MSGE Since this is the kind of life we have chosen, the life of the Spirit, let us make sure that we do not just hold it as an idea in our heads or a sentiment in our hearts, but work out its implications in every detail of our lives.

I only stand sin-free by God's grace; so I must be humble about the shortcomings of others

26 **Let us not become proud, competitive and challenging and provoking and irritating to one another, envying and being jealous of one another. AMP**

Gal 6:1 Brothers and sisters, if anyone is overtaken in misconduct or sin of any sort you who are spiritual, who are responsive to and controlled by the Spirit, should set them right and restore and reinstate them, without any sense of superiority and with all gentleness, keeping an attentive eye on yourself, lest you should be tempted also. AMP

Gal 6:2 Bear, endure, carry one another's burdens and troublesome moral faults (in believing intercessory prayer) and in this way fulfill and observe perfectly the law of Christ and complete what is lacking in your obedience to it. AMP
