

Anca's Dream or Vision of a backslidden Church

With reference to Anca's dream or vision of a fat, naked lady lying on a bed, which implies laziness, with me kneeling beside her in tears. Here is an interpretation:

The lady: Is the Church, the intended bride and wife of Christ, comprised of millions of unsanctified, unholy, backslidden and therefore nowhere near fully saved Christians.

Rev 21:9 ...**"Come, I will show you the bride, the Lamb's wife."**

2 Thes 2:13 ...**God from the beginning chose you for salvation through sanctification (through holiness) by the Spirit and belief in the truth,**

She is Fat or carrying much excess weight: She is heavy laden, loaded down with sin, weight she refuses to lay aside; in large part because she will not exercise – exercise her faith to believe God's words and to fully put her trust in Him:

Matt 11:28 **Come to Me, all you who labor and are heavy laden...**

2 Tim 3:6 ...**Gullible women loaded down with sins, led away by various lusts**

Heb 12:1 ...**Let us lay aside every weight, and the sin which so easily ensnares us, and let us run with endurance the race that is set before us,**

Ps 2:12 ...**Blessed are all those who put (exercise) their trust in Him.**

She is naked because she is not clothed with a wedding garment of righteousness

Isa 61:10 ...**My soul shall be joyful in my God; For He has clothed me with the garments of salvation, He has covered me with the robe of righteousness...**

Rev 16:15 (Jesus) **Behold, I am coming as a thief. Blessed is he who watches, and keeps his garments, lest he walk naked and they see his shame.**

Rev 19:7-8 **Let us be glad and rejoice and give Him glory, for the marriage of the Lamb has come, and His wife has made herself ready. And to her it was granted to be arrayed in fine linen, clean and bright, for the fine linen is the righteousness of the saints.**

Matt 22:11-12 **But when the king came in to see the guests, he saw a man there who did not have on a wedding garment (righteousness). So he said to him, 'Friend, how did you come in here without a wedding garment?' (not righteous, still under sin, that is, self-willed) And he was speechless.**

13-14 **The king said to the servants 'Bind him hand and foot,...and cast him into outer darkness; there will be weeping and gnashing of teeth.' For many are called (to be sin free) but few are chosen (those saved from sin).**

She is lazy, the opposite of diligent, her lips aren't bearing the fruit of God's words:

Prov 24:30-31 **I went by the field (the heart) of the lazy person, And by the vineyard of the man devoid of understanding; And there it was, all overgrown with thorns; Its surface was covered with nettles (with lies, presumptions, reasonings and false teachings about God); Its stone wall was broken down (the will is unable to say no to many lusts and thoughts and so is still an unsaved soul).**

32-34 When I saw it, I considered it well; I looked on it and received instruction: A little (spiritual) sleep, a little slumber, A little folding of the hands to rest; So shall your (spiritual) poverty come like a prowler...your need like an armed man.

Matt 25:24-25 (Jesus) **He who had received the one talent (Sufficient of the Grace, of God, to be re-born) came and said, 'Lord, I knew you to be a hard man (a false view of God) reaping where you have not sown, and gathering where you have not scattered seed. And I was afraid, and went and hid your talent in the ground. (A carnal Christian neither becoming nor making disciples)...But his Lord said to him:**

26-27 'You wicked and lazy servant...you ought to have deposited my money with the bankers (invested yourself fully in My Church), and at my coming I would have received back my own with interest (your soul with others you jointly won).

28-30 So take the talent from him (the fruitless Christian)...For to everyone who has (fruit), more will be given...but from him who does not have (fruit), even what he has will be taken away (his initial salvation). And cast him into the outer darkness. There will be weeping...' (This is love's clear warning to every Christian).

Col 1:10 So that you may walk worthy of the Lord, fully pleasing Him, abounding in fruitfulness (speaking by the Holy Spirit)...increasing in the knowledge of God;

The person kneeling beside the lady, weeping, is an intercessor bearing God's words:

Phil 3:18-19 **For many (Christians) walk, of whom I have told you often, and now tell you even weeping, that they are the enemies of the cross of Christ: whose end is destruction, whose god is their appetite, whose glory is in their shame — all they think about is their (natural) life on earth. (To these Jesus has this to say):**

Rev 3:17-18 (Jesus) **You say, 'I am rich, have become wealthy, and have need of nothing' — and do not know that you are wretched, miserable, poor, blind, and naked — I counsel you to buy from Me...white garments, that you may be clothed (made righteous) that the shame of your nakedness may not be revealed;**

Isa 66:8 **...As soon as Zion travailed (in prayer) she brought forth her children. KJV**

Ps 126:5-6 **Those who sow in tears Shall reap in joy. He who continually goes forth weeping, Bearing precious seed (God's living words) for sowing, Shall doubtless come again with rejoicing, Bringing his sheaves with him (the souls God has revived and harvested through him and the prayers and preaching of others).**
